Legislative Biography



VA Del. Kimberly "Kim" Taylor is a Delegate in the Virginia General Assembly who represents the 63rd district and received 50.7% of the vote in her last election. She is a member of the Transportation Accountability, Small Business, Communications, Technology and Innovation, Transportation, and Privileges and Elections committees.

She works most frequently on Education (43 bills), Crime and Law Enforcement (41 bills), Law (37 bills), Health (33 bills), and Labor and Employment (23 bills). She has sponsored 14 bills in her last year in office, voting with her party 97.3% of the time, getting 71.43% of her bills out of committee, and 50.0% of her sponsored bills enacted.

Del. Taylor most frequently works on legislation with William Wiley (R-VA-29) (69 bills), Wendell Walker (R-VA-23) (67 bills), and Wren Williams (R-VA-9) (66 bills). She most frequently votes with Leslie Adams (R-VA-16) (98.75%), Terry Austin (R-VA-19) (96.98%), and Howard Wachsmann (R-VA-75) (96.92%).
