## Legislative Biography



VA Del. Karen Greenhalgh is a Delegate in the Virginia General Assembly who represents the 85th district and received 50.2% of the vote in her last election. She is a member of the Education, Public Safety, Health Care, Finance, and Small Business committees.

She works most frequently on Education (38 bills), Law (35 bills), Crime and Law Enforcement (32 bills), Health (29 bills), and Labor and Employment (15 bills). She has sponsored 21 bills in her last one year(s) in office, voting with her party 96.9% of the time, getting 85.71% of her bills out of committee, and 42.86% of her sponsored bills enacted.

Del. Greenhalgh most frequently works on legislation with Wren Williams (R-VA-9) (57 bills), David LaRock (R-VA-33) (56 bills), and G. John Avoli (R-VA-20) (55 bills). She most frequently votes with Don Scott (D-VA-80) (97.77%), William Wiley (R-VA-29) (96.68%), and Emily Brewer (R-VA-64) (96.5%).
